



LOW VOLUME AND RESIDENTIAL RPP ELECTION FORM

Please fill out this form if you are a low volume or residential consumer and want to change the Regulated Price Plan (RPP) structure that applies to the Electricity supplied by London Hydro.

There are two rate options: **Time-of-Use** (TOU) and **Tiered** (TIER). Under **Time-of-Use** pricing, the price you pay for electricity depends on when you use it. Under **Tiered** pricing, you can use a certain amount of electricity at a lower price, and once that limit (tier) is exceeded, a higher price applies. ³ An eligible residential unit means a unit that is a self-contained set of rooms located in a building or structure, contains kitchen and bathroom facilities that are intended for the use of the unit only, and is used or intended for use as a residential premises - please see the regulation filed under 156/15 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, and Ontario Reg 493/01 for more details.
